Investors in Zimbabwe have long relied on PDFs, WhatsApp tips, and manual calculations.

ShareholderView bridges that gap by combining public filings, ownership records, financial statements, and live market data into a structured, visual format — ready for analysis or automation.

2.1 Creating Your Account

Go to shareholderview.com

Click Login → Enter your email, password, or signin with Google account. Verify your email — you'll receive a confirmation link.

Once verified, log in and start your free trial.

If you don't receive your verification email, check your spam folder or click "Resend Verification" on the login page.

3. Portfolio Analytics


3.1 Overview


In one glance, you see how many counters you hold, how they've done this month, and which positions are pulling you up or down. It cuts through the guesswork.

4. Holdings Editor

3.1 Overview

The Holdings Editor lets you manage and update your positions manually or through CDS integration (for supported brokers).

To Add or Update:

- Navigate to Holdings
- · Adjust company, shares, or purchase date
- Click Save Changes

All updates reflect immediately in your analytics and charts.

If your CDS-linked account is active, your holdings sync automatically every 24 hours.




5.1 Overview




6.Market Heatmap




7.1 Ownership Analytics




9. Share History.

10.3 How It Works

- Data aggregation Each Friday, ShareholderView compiles your latest portfolio metrics and market data.
- Al analysis Our model interprets the data to detect trends, anomalies, or performance shifts.
- Narrative generation A concise, readable email report is generated, blending numbers and storylines.
- Delivery Emails are sent automatically to your verified address.
 Premium users also receive a WhatsApp link to open the interactive version.
